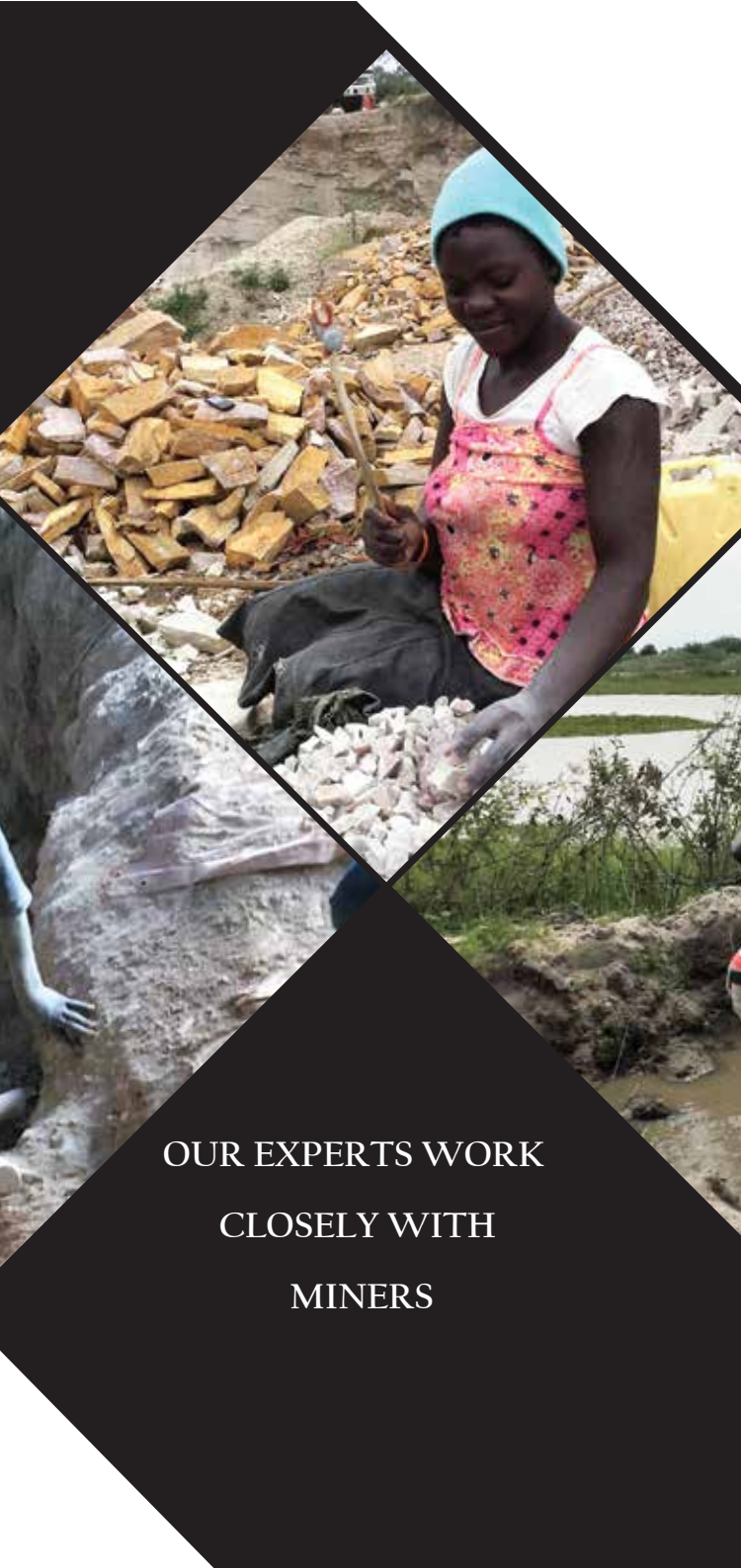


OUR VISION

WHY AEMI NOW?

The Energy and Mineral sectors are the main driver of economic development in various countries globally. Many African countries are a home to massive oil, gas, energy and mineral resources and yet majority of people remain very poor depending on less than one dollar a day. Additionally, these activities if not well managed in a sustainable manner, they have often led to environmental and human rights abuses.

Moreover, most of the existing initiatives focus on publishing reports and as such they have not adequately addressed the practical challenges faced in these sectors including those faced by artisanal miners and the local communities where these resources are extracted from.

- a) Our experts do fieldwork research to better understand the practical challenges in the Energy and Mineral sectors of Africa.

- c) AEMI has come up with strategies to change the techniques and methods used by Artisanal Miners.
- d) We coordinate and closely work with local communities, government institutions, engineering companies, donors and investors to ensure access to advanced and affordable technology by artisanal miners. Access to advanced technology is key to ensure that artisanal mining contributes positively to the economies of different African countries.
- e) We reach out to women and children involved in the extractive industries. Through policy analysis, capacity building and community engagement, AEMI contributes positively to the efforts aimed at addressing gender inequality and child labour in the Energy and Mineral Sectors.
- f) We provide protective equipment to miners and we have set up strategies that will ensure that miners can access protective gears at an affordable price.
- g) AEMI sensitizes the community on the use of green energy. Switching over to green energy is important, as it will cut back on fossil fuel

emissions which are the main contributor of climate change.

h) Through various tabloids, conferences and workshops, we advocate for developmental infrastructure in areas where the resources are extracted from.
